


The end of 2015 saw the anticipated changes in Amelie. The name Amelie, o.s. was changed to Amelie, z.s. General meeting was held and new management was appointed in compliance with the changes in the Amelie statutes and its change to registered association. The process of registration in the Register of Associations is underway.

The above mentioned changes have completed one phase of Amelie but did not alter its objectives, mission or vision.

Our vision: situation in which cancer is being considered simply a part of life.

The mission of Amelie remains the same: **we help people live with cancer**. We provide our support actively and directly to those who need and want it.

Our goal is to establish at least one Amelie Centre in each region and thus offer a range of individual and group activities for the clients and at the same time support voluntary involvement.

Amelie values: partnership, trust and expertise.

Amelie actively seeks partnership and cooperation with hospitals, patient organisations, experts and lay people. Among our closest partners are the teaching hospitals in Prague and Olomouc, hospitals in Liberec, Rakovník and Příbram, the Na Pleši Hospital and the Na Bulovce Hospital in Prague. Amelie is also a member of NRZP, SKOK, UNO and the League Against Cancer.











In 2015 Amelie successfully passed various audits of its obligations, namely the audit of grant management, financial audit, and also the internal process of evaluation by an independent organisation (Asociace veřejně prospěšných organizací ČR; AVPO). The AVPO evaluation resulted in Amelie getting the seal of reliability and since the summer of 2015 Amelie has been entitled to use the certificate of reliability.

Besides its regular activities and projects Amelie has been preparing for the anticipated change of the organisation to "zapsaný spolek" (registered association). This major change took place at the general meeting in December 2015 where the new statutes were adopted and the elections to the association's bodies were held.

Amelie employed 34 people in 2015. The average standard number of employees in primary employment relationship was 4. The sum of three highest salaries in Amelie (including social security contributions) was CZK 1,239,726.

Financial information

Our aim is to use various sources of finance for Amelie activities. To this end, we have established the Social Enterprise as well as our public fund-raising activities and projects that enhance communication with potential donors. The Tulip Month project that addresses general public in Prague is one of our most visible activities but there are others, such as traditional charity concerts in Olomouc or cultural and social meetings of "Iva and her friends" in Rakovník. Amelie also organises smaller local events which draw attention to our range of services and may open new opportunities for the clients as well as for potential donors or partners. Projects implemented in 2015

Amelie Centres and help line

Amelie has been established with the aim of supporting cancer patients and their loved ones by offering a comprehensive programme of professional help, which is easily available and tailored to individual needs. Following the example of the extent of psycho-social support as it is provided in many developed countries, our services include psychological help; social counselling; activities focused on helping clients to manage the stress and come to terms with their illness, the treatment and its effects; information services and sharing. All our activities are designed to support and supplement the medical treatment in a way that is most beneficial not only to the cancer patients and their loved ones but also to the society as a whole. The Centres play a key role in offering the necessary support. In the locations where there is no Amelie Centre available, the Amelie help line may substitute its services, to a limited extent. In 2015 Amelie offered its range of psycho-social support services in its Amelie Centres in Liberec, Olomouc, Prague, Příbram and Rakovník, and also via telephone or e-mail through the Amelie help line. In total, there were 2,263 con-

tacts with cancer patients or their relatives through participation in individual or group activities. We provided information, counselling (including registered social services, family counselling, support for couples and counselling for men), support in situations of change, stress relief and prevention, self-development and participatory activities organised to suit the specific needs and related restraints of oncology patients. In particular our services provided to clients included art therapy, relaxation and breathing exercises, basic and professional social counselling – but also an opportunity to relax in an informal environment, enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and talk to other people.

In addition to the above-mentioned activities, the Centres organised 2 rehabilitation programmes, a number of cultural events and 2 other projects – Theme Months and Art Therapy for Cancer Patients.

Amelie Centre in Liberec

The Amelie Centre in Liberec is the most recently opened Centre which we managed to open in the spring of 2015. It is the first professional organisation that offers psycho-social support to cancer patients and their loved ones in the Liberec region. In 2015 the Centre was opened to clients two days a week. Thanks to close collaboration with the hospital our social workers provided their services also directly at the outpatient oncology department. The offered range of services includes individual consultations with a social worker focused both on counselling and providing contacts and information.

Amelie Centre in Olomouc

The Amelie Centre in Olomouc has been offering its services since 2007. Within the framework of its registered social services it provides participatory activities for senior citizens and people with disabilities. In 2015 the Centre was open to clients every Monday between 15:00–18:00, offering individual consultations with a social worker or a psychologist and providing counselling as well as general information and contacts. The Centre's group activities regularly included art therapy, drama therapy, creative workshop, support group meetings and other participatory and relaxation activities. A counselling service for men (led by a psychologist) was available every second Friday between 15:00–16:00. By June 1 the Centre started operating in its own and larger premises which allow it to extend the range of services and organise events for wider public. Since September, the discussion events entitled "Evenings with Amelie" have been organised regularly, introducing various interesting guests, and also other new events have taken place.

Amelie Centre in Prague

The Amelie Centre in Prague offers psycho-social support to cancer patients and their loved ones through registered social services (Professional social counselling and Social services and participatory activities for senior citizens and disabled people) as well as complementary services (e.g. art therapy, patient meetings, family counselling and support for couples, stress prevention, coaching). Four new activities have enriched our range of services: Memory training, Culture with Amelie, Physical activities based on dance/movement therapy, and educational programme Back to Work. The Centre provides its services four days a week (Monday – Thursday).

Theme Months in the Amelie Centre in Prague

In 2015 we continued with this project focusing on prevention and everyday life with cancer. Each month we chose one type of cancer and a programme of lectures, online lectures (organised in collaboration with Seppia), discussions and workshops was prepared to explain the specific problems and limitations related to such illness and also to present various options of medical help and available support. On the Amelie website, a special section was created for each diagnosis, containing links to information about available treatment and contacts to organisations offering help and support. In total, the Centre organised 34 events, in which 24 lecturers presented (excluding the Amelie employees). The website of the Theme Months project continues to offer information to all those who need it.

Other one-off events organised by the Amelie Centre in Prague in 2015:

Doors Open Day

This year we held the Doors Open Day in June, offering visitors the opportunity to meet members of Amelie team and familiarize themselves with our range or services. Music performance and refreshments were also part of the programme.

Presentation at Fairs and Days of Social Services

Throughout the year the Centre and its activities were presented at various fairs and Days of Social Services, including the Easter



Fair of Prague 8, NGO Market, Social Services Market of Prague 12 or Day of Healthcare and Social Services organised by Prague 8 district.

A gathering for our clients, volunteers, employees and supporters of Amelie was held in December. The participants had the chance to taste home-made Christmas cookies and punch as well as join in singing the Christmas carols, creating Christmas cards or testing their knowledge of history by taking part in our Christmas Quiz.

Amelie Centre in Příbram

The Centre in Příbram Hospital was opened in April 2014 and it was available to clients at least one day a week between 9:00 – 14:00. It offered individual consultations as well as regular group activities, in particular art therapy, breathing exercises, and a tea room. Unfortunately the oncology ward was moved to other part of the hospital complex in the spring of 2015, making the Centre difficult to access, without direct connection with the outpatient department. This and some other reasons led to our decision to temporarily suspend operations of the Centre in July 2015.

While being the smallest of all Amelie Centres, the Amelie Centre in Rakovník operates in very close collaboration with the Masaryk Hospital in Rakovník where the regular client meetings take place. Besides the regular programme the Centre offers additional activities such as rehabilitation programmes and cultural/social events.

The Centre offers its services every week and its regular client group meetings are held bi-weekly, on Thursdays between 14:00 – 17:00. The services provided include namely participatory activities – physical exercise, Nordic walking, excursions and group activities focused on experience sharing where the cancer patients and their loved ones can offer support and encouragement to one another.

Amelie places great emphasis on thorough preparation – its pro-



fessionalism, practicality and interconnectedness. Therefore we use as trainers the team of specialists in the field of oncology and volunteering, which provides the participants of our courses with an opportunity to ask specific questions while visiting the hospitals and oncology wards. The training courses are held in the Na Pleši Hospital and in Olomouc.

Amelie volunteer programme in Olomouc

In 2015 the volunteer programme in Olomouc took place in two inpatient wards of the Olomouc Teaching Hospital's Oncology Department. Project "Returning to work after cancer"



April 2015 saw the completion of our 2-year project aiming to provide cancer patients with comprehensive support and help them find and retain a suitable job. The project was focused on people of working age living in the Central Bohemia region who underwent cancer treatment and receive disability pension. The project with registration number CZ.1.04/3.3.05/96.00192 was part of OP LZZ and was financed by the European Social Fund and by the state budget of the Czech Republic. In 2015 Amelie implemented its final phase which included securing jobs for as many participants as possible as well as final evaluation of the project.

Total number of participants was 59 (55 women and 4 men), with breast cancer as the most common diagnosis (54% participants). 31 succeeded to secure employment (i.e. 53% participants of the project), most commonly in administration, followed by social services. 71% of the clients who managed to secure jobs settled for part-time employment, the remaining percentage bravely opted for full-time jobs.

Accredited professional education

Amelie Social Enterprise is a project that we started to implement in the middle of 2012. It was focused on accredited education of professional and general public and in a long term it aimed to help finance operating costs of Amelie and its non-profit activities. At the same time, the project was implemented with regard to the mission and objectives of Amelie which include educational activities in the fields of psycho-oncology and psychosocial support for cancer patients and their loved ones.

Following the evaluation of the outcomes of our social enterprise in 2015, we decided to gradually reduce its activities and eventually discontinue the project. Education plays an important role in Amelie but not as an independent profitable activity. That was partly why only 3 educational events were organised in 2015. The events were attended by social care and healthcare professionals and their evaluation shows that participants appreciated the quality of our seminars and considered them well prepared and interesting.

Project "Cancer patient in the family"



This new educational project aimed at prevention was implemented by Amelie in 2015. The project targets pupils of 8th grade at elementary schools or high schools. The objective is to familiarize young people with the cancer patient problems and needs, prepare them for a possibility that someone in their family may get ill and inform them about preventive measures that may protect them against cancer. The project offers 2-hour educational seminar which includes a lecture, a group work, video with patient stories and discussion. Students also get a leaflet with useful contacts concerning psycho-social issues of cancer patients and the school libraries receive the information booklet "Psycho-social minimum for cancer patients and their loved ones". The pilot phase of the project was implemented in selected schools in Prague (e.g. ZŠ Radlická,

ZŠ Palmovka, Gymnázium na Vítězné Pláni). We could see that the students are able to openly discuss even such a difficult topic and are keen to get more information. According to teachers' assessment the programme is very useful. The project was supported by the League Against Cancer and the Prague Municipal Authority.

Art therapy in Amelie

Art therapy has become an integral part of our support programmes for cancer patients and their families, being offered both by the Amelie Centres and through our volunteer programme in hospitals. It includes individual and group art therapy sessions, creative workshops, visits to art exhibitions, music therapy group sessions, drama therapy, physical activity workshops or club programmes. With welcome gift of colouring books for adults we were able to introduce and offer the activities in various oncology departments in 2015 enabling the patients to benefit from this easy and beneficial form of therapy.



More than 150 activities were organised in 2015 resulting in more than 550 contacts with patients. Amelie employees and volunteers donated over 290 hours to the programme.

Tulip month 2015

The third Tulip Month was held in March 2015 with the aim to bring hope and joy to cancer patients, inform people about the range of psycho-social support offered by the Amelie Centres, and raise funds for further provision of free-of-charge services.

The launching event of 2015 Tulip Month was traditionally held in the gallery KusKovu, which organised an exhibition and auction of various designers' objects entitled Matters of the Heart. Seventeen designers supported the project by donating their work.

A record number of schools got involved in the project. Their students donated almost 1,500 pictures with tulip motif for decoration of oncology clinics. Our volunteers used them to decorate 12 oncology departments in Prague, Olomouc, Příbram, Kolín and in the Na Pleši Hospital. At some departments, the pictures needed to be replaced as some of the

patients wanted to take them home as a reminder. Amelie volunteers prepared also other pleasant sur-

prises and activities for cancer patients in both outpatient departments and inpatient wards. During the month of March they visited approximately 190 patients, playing for them the songs they wished for and organising creative workshops.

The Amelie Centre in Prague held a series of events focused on issues of psycho-social support to patients and their families as well as discussions with volunteers introducing their experiences from Amelie volunteer programme. The lecture of PhDr. Jiřina Šiklová, CSc., (entitled "Death. Taboo of our present times?") was also part of the programme. By now we can hardly imagine the Tulip Month without accompanying sale of tulip bouquets. The offer was extended this year to include more than one tulip or bouquet so that our tulips could bring joy to many people, including visitors to participating companies, clients or employees. In collaboration with Papavera flower shop approximately 2,500 tulips were sold and the total proceeds reached CZK 26,224.

Our already abundant programme was further enriched by "Jarní veletrh...ák" – a concert organised by our volunteer Romana Vlčková and her daughter Eliška. About 60 performers donated their time and art, resulting in the proceeds of almost CZK 20,000.

We would like to extend our thanks to all participants, supporters and partners. The project continues to be presented on our website.

Conference" I slova léčí II." (Words have the power to heal)

Two years after our last event, Amelie organised another conference focused on psycho-social issues of oncology. The conference was organised in collaboration with the General Teaching Hospital (VFN) in Prague on 5 November 2015 and was held on the premises of the 1st Medical Faculty of the Charles University and VFN in Prague. 57 professionals participated in the conference and listened to 14 lecturers, including 2 guest speakers from the UK and Poland. All of the lectures were concerned with the topic of psycho-social support to cancer patients and



their families. Among the lecturers and participants were psychologists, social workers, nurses, pastors and representatives of patient organisations. The feedback shows that 96% of participants considered the programme to be excellent and 93% believe that it is highly essential to communicate the need of comprehensive care and support to cancer patients and their loved ones. Return rate of the evaluation questionnaire was 51%. According to the participants, lectures by foreign speakers were most beneficial but they also highly appreciated the entire programme, chosen topics and expertise of all speakers.

Expertise in Amelie



Amelie has been established as a patient organisation aiming to provide expert care and support. That is why Amelie has formed a team of experts that helps prepare the range of services provided and also presents Amelie, its results and psycho-social issues in general. In 2015 Amelie gave presentations at the following conferences: Prague ONCO (January 2015), IPOS (July 2015), Annual conference of Alliance of women suffering from breast cancer (November 2015), and a conference in the Parliament entitled "Does the medical evaluation service merit conceptual change?" (November 2015).

Amelie also had its representative at the World Congress on Psycho-Oncology APOS/IPOS in Washington, D.C. The outcomes from the event help us deepen our education and broaden our knowledge of psycho-social support to cancer patients and their loved ones, as well as introduce best practices and apply them in practice. What made our participation even more valuable was the opportunity to get a comparison with different approaches used in other cultures or continents. For example, we learned that in the US, measurement of psychological distress in patients with cancer is becoming a standard practice, being recognized as a necessary and effective technique.


