Hotel Astrid

How to reach Hotel Astrid:

From Brussels Airport (Zaventem)

Train to Central station (duration: 20 minutes)

Take the metro to “De Brouckère” (line 1 direction “Gare de l’Ouest” or line 5 direction “Erasmus”

or

From North station

Pre-metro to “De Brouckère” (lines 3 or 4 direction Stalle/Churchill, 2 stops, 3 min.)

or

From South station

Pre-metro to “De Brouckère” (lines 3 or 4 direction “Esplanade/Gare du Nord”, 4 stops, 5 min.)

or

From the European Institutions

Metro from “Schuman” or “Arts-Loi” to “De Brouckère” (line 1 direction “Gare de l’Ouest” or line 5 direction “Erasmus” with respectively 5 or 3 stops)

Then, for all

Exit the metro “De Brouckère” following the direction “rue de Laeken”

Take the first street on the right “rue des Augustins”, next to the “Phillips” building
